Assignment #2: Standards, Objectives, Pre-Assessment Plan, Formative Assessment Plan

Use the link provided on the class website – Internet Links/Curriculum Standards – to access the Ohio curriculum standards governing your content area. If a grade level is indicated, choose one standard from that level.

- 1. Give complete reference for the standard Document title, hierarchy, statement of standard (copy and paste), and page number.
- 2. Write 3 measurable objectives (aka learning targets) that tell what students should know and/or be able to do to meet this standard as demonstrated through an end of unit test. Give the criterion for success at each level or as an overall criterion.
 - a. One objective at Bloom's knowledge or comprehension level
 - b. One objective at Bloom's application level
 - c. One objective at Bloom's analysis or synthesis level

- c. The student will compare and contrast 2 examples of figurative language, e.g. simile and metaphor, with 80% accuracy. (Analysis level)
